Let this hand represent you and me.

The Bible says:

(Ecclesiastes 7:20)*

*“For all have sinned, and come short of the
glory of God” (Romans 3:23)*



**Let this hand represent the Lord Jesus Christ.
He had no sin.**

The Bible says:

“For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him” (2 Corinthians 5:21)



Our sin separates us from God.

The Bible says:

*“But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear”
(Isaiah 59:2)*



We cannot get rid of our sin on our own.

The Bible says:

“But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away” (Isaiah 64:6)

*“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast”
(Ephesians 2:8,9)*



If we were to pay for our sin, we would have to pay for it for all eternity away from God's holy presence.

The Bible says:

"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord"
(Romans 6:23)



God loves us.

The Bible says:

*“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only
begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not
perish, but have everlasting life”
(John 3:16)*



**But, He hates our sin. And sin can never dwell
in Heaven with God.**

The Bible says:

*“For thou art not a God that hath pleasure in wickedness:
neither shall evil dwell with thee” (Psalm 5:4)*



Christ, who had no sin, willingly took our sin upon Himself.

The Bible says:

“All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all” (Isaiah 53:5)

“Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed” (1 Peter 2:24)



Jesus, the sinless Savior, paid for our sin by dying in our place on the cross. Than rising again from the dead, He gives us His righteousness so we can dwell in Heaven.

The Bible says:

“But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us”
(Romans 5:8)

“For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him”
(2 Corinthians 5:21)



There is now no separation for us from God.

The Bible says:

“Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ” (Romans 5:1)

“For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord” (Romans 8:38,39)



You can know now that you have the gift of eternal life, when you by faith accept that payment Christ made for you.
